## Airline Reservations

We will gladly assist you with your airline reservations. The group will be departing on KLM, Royal Dutch Airlines, from Washington Dulles on June 9, 2009. We will connect in Amsterdam to a KLM flight to Mt. Kilimanjaro. The return flight on KLM departs on June 17, 2009 via Amsterdam to Washington Dulles. If you plan on using an airline mileage plan for your tickets, you should plan on starting now. There will be

limited seat inventory for Mileage used seats. For airline reservation assistance, please call out international travel service team at 240-387-4033. Because KLM has a monopoly on flights to Kilimanjaro, some participants in the past have chosen to fly to Nairobi, Kenya, and then fly from Nairobi to Kilimanjaro the next morning. (Requires an overnight in Kenya Airport Hotel). The airfares to Nairobi from USA are lower.

# Day-By-Day Itinerary

## Day 1 June 09 - Depart North America

Your journey begins as you board your flight to Europe. (Except those that are traveling via Nairobi)

## Day 2 June 10, 2009 - Arrive Kilimanjaro / Arusha

Arrive in Europe and connect with your flight(s) to Tanzania. Upon arrival, you will be met and escorted to Mt. Meru Game Lodge, near Arusha.

Those flying to Kilimanjaro via Nairobi will depart the USA one day earlier and overnight in Kenya. You will then fly to Kilimanjaro the next morning to hook up with the group.

## Day 3 June 11, 2009 - Lake Manyara National Park

This morning visit a Multi-Tribal village including visits to a local school where we attend a classroom in session and bring school supplies. There is a Q&A session with the students and tour participants.

Afternoon game drive in Lake Manyara National Park.

On your half-day game drive to Lake Manyara Park, you'll find an abundance of wildlife, including hippos, zebras, giraffes, buffaloes, leopards, impalas, wildebeests, baboons and monkeys. Overnight at E Unoto Luxury Lodge. (BLD)

## Day 4 June 12, 2009 - Lake Manyara National Park / Ngorongoro Crater

This Morning, ascend through the highlands to the very rim of the Ngorongoro Crater (world's largest). Situated on the crater's rim, Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge offers a magnificent view of the crater below. From there, descend into the crater for a full afternoon of game viewing. Vast herds of wildebeest, zebra, gazelle, buffalo, and their predators—the big cats—roam the crater floor. You will see some of the 25 only remaining black Rhino in the world. Overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge (BLD)

## Day 5 June 13, 2009 - Ngorongoro Crater

Full day game drive in world famous Ngorongoro Crater. Overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge (BLD)



## Day 6 June 14, 2009 - Olduvai Gorge / Serengeti National Park

Visit an archeological site at Olduvai Gorge. Continue to Serengeti National Park, one of the finest game parks in all of Africa. After settling in at the lodge, embark on an afternoon game drive. Overnight at Sopa Serengeti Lodge. (BLD)

## Day 7 June 15, 2009 - Serengeti National Park

The morning we will be searching the Serengeti along the river for leopard, or exploring some of the rocky kopjes hills for lions or cheetah resting in the shade. A hot air balloon safari (very early in the Am) is available on request (additional cost). Overnight at Migration Tented Camp. (BLD)

## Day 8 June 16, 2009 - Serengeti National Park

Full day game drive in the northern section of Kilimanjaro near the Kenyan Border. Here you will see (dates in June vary for the migration) the world's greatest migration in the world of hundreds of thousands wildebeests and zebra on their journey to Kenya.

## Day 9 June 17, 2009 - Game Drive

This morning's pre-breakfast game drive is your final opportunity to bask in the unmatched grandeur of the African safari lands before flying to Arusha for lunch. A day room is provided at Mt. Meru Game Lodge prior to your transfer to Kilimanjaro Airport for your evening departure flight. (BL)

Arrive home today, your mind and heart filled with many treasured sights and moments from fascinating Tanzania.

**TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES**

TOUR DATES: (Departure from U.S) June 9, 2009

DEPOSIT: A deposit in the amount of \$1,000 per person is due at time of registration. Due to the small group size, registrations will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Upon receipt of the deposit payment, Travel-On will send you a written confirmation along with a payment invoice, including any extensions in Europe or Africa.

FINAL PAYMENT: Final payment will be due by 90 days prior to departure date. Final payment can be made by a check or any major credit card.

- » Tour application form must be completed accurately.
- » Tour itinerary is subject to change at any time.

CANCELLATION PENALTIES: The following charges will be applied on the full tour cost.

- » Cancellation received more than 90 days prior to departure date is subject to a \$200 penalty.
- » Cancellation received between 89 to 60 days prior to departure date is subject to a 50% penalty.
- » Cancellations received between 59 to 30 days prior to departure are subject to a 75% penalty.

- » Cancellations received within 30 days prior to departure are subject to a 100% penalty of total.

To protect against cancellation charges, Travel-On strongly recommends purchasing the cancellation insurance. Details are available upon request.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Generally we reserve rooms based on two persons sharing a double room. Single rooms are reserved at supplementary cost. We reserve the right to book accommodation at alternative hotels/lodges where hotels/lodges named are not available.

TRANSPORTATION: Transport on safari is provided in Toyota 4x4 or Land Rover 4 wheel-drive vehicles. The company reserves the right to employ the services of sub-contractors.

NATIONAL PARK RULES: Please observe rules of various parks for your own safety.

ALTERATION TO TOURS: Every effort is made to adhere to itineraries advised to clients. However, should it be necessary to change the sequence or lodge due to weather conditions, or any other cause, the company reserves the right to do so.

TOUR PRICES: Prices are based on prevailing tariffs at the time of printing and are subject to change if government park fees and taxes change

UNUSED TOUR ITEMS: No refund will be made for any unused accommodations, missed meals, transportation segments, sightseeing tours, or any other service. Such unused items are neither refundable nor exchangeable (no exceptions).

LIABILITY: Travel-On and its agents in Tanzania accept no responsibility for personal injury, accident, illness, death, delays, theft, loss or damage to baggage or any other personal properties or alteration or cancellation of itinerary due to force majeure. Travel-On will not be held responsible for delays, cancellation or non-acceptance of reservation of air space.
